MEMORANDA.

1. This Pay-list, *after* being receipted by every man of the Corps (or by his Attorney in his absence), and duly witnessed and certified, will be sent to the Militia Department, Ottawa, the Captain *retaining* the duplicate of it as his own voucher. No pay will however be issued until *after* the Annual General Inspection.
2. In order to be entitled to pay for the year ending 30th June 1866, it is absolutely necessary that the Pay-list, properly completed, be received at this Department not *later* than the 1st day of June 1866.

The following Certificate is to be granted in all cases where the Arms of the Volunteers are kept in Private Armories.

I do hereby certify that the Arms of this Corps are clean and in good order in every respect; that there is no *Public* Armory available for their Storage, and that the Officer Commanding the Corps is therefore entitled to the Government allowance* for care of Arms accordingly, under Sec. 9 of the existing Volunteer Militia Act.
