14184 Niagara Parkway: *from Brock's Monument walk to your left and look for the statues.*

Fun Fact: The school was named after Willoughby-born Albert Nicholas Myer. The school first opened its doors in 1957, thirty-three years after Mr. Myer retired from a long and successful career in education. Myer was there for the school's official opening.

**Niagara Falls City Hall**

Fun Fact: The famous Canada-wide run this person attempted in 1980 was known as the Marathon of Hope.

**Niagara Falls Military Museum**

5049 Victoria Avenue

The Military Museum is currently housed in the 1911 Armoury building; what was this building used for between 1914-1918?

Fun Fact: This was one of 11 armouries built between 1896-1911, a time of reform and expansion for the Canadian Militia.

**Louis Tussaud's Waxworks**5709 Victoria Avenue, *no need to stop the car or get out for this one, just look up!*

What is strung across the street above the traffic? _____

Fun Fact: In 1859, Charles Blondin was the first person to complete this death-defying act across the Niagara Gorge. A person who does this feat is also known as a funambulist.

**Portage Bakery**

5845 Gladstone Avenue

Fun Fact: Portage Bakery opened in 1934 and is one of our City's oldest bakeries.



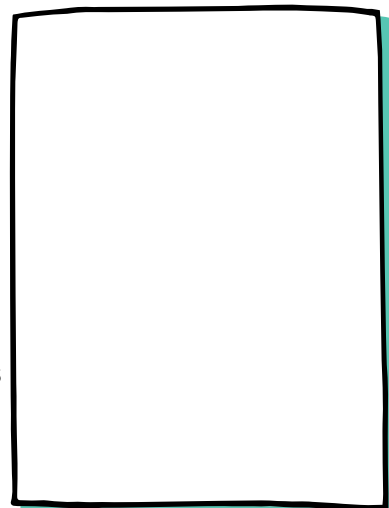
BME Church, Nathaniel Dett Memorial Chapel

5674 Peer Street

What colour is the church ? _____

Across the street you will see a street sign. It is a sign for _____ Avenue. On the sign is a symbol - draw it in the box provided. This symbol is associated with the **Underground Railroad**.

Fun Fact: This building was constructed in 1836 by the early Black settlers of the Niagara region. Its original site was at the intersection of Murray Street, Main Street and Allendale Avenue. The church was rolled on logs to its current site in 1856.

Fun Fact: Take a look across the river, what Island do you see? _____ (refer to google maps if you need help). This island has a long history, including evidence of Indigenous use over 3000 years ago, a base for rebels fighting in the Upper Canada Rebellion in 1837, and it even almost became the location of United Nations Headquarters in 1945!
